

#### Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2015-16




#### Enrollment by gender, student level, and full- and part-time status: Fall 2016




### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2016




# Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2016








Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2010 cohort






