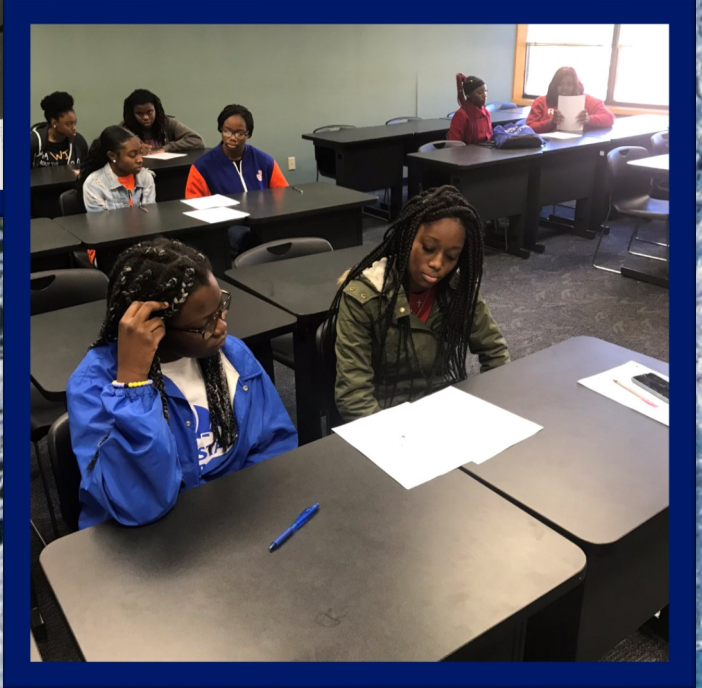

ACT Reading Tips

- Start With Your Strengths
- Skim Passages

ACT Science Tips

- Do the Conflicting Viewpoints Section Last
- Rely On Visuals

ACT Essay Tips

- Pre-plan Examples
- Write a Great Intro and Conclusion

Overall ACT Tips

- Skip Hard Questions
- Use the Process of Elimination
- Bubble at the End
